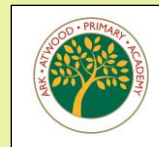

All children should wear their Atwood PE kit to school on this day and should bring a sunhat, water, sunscreen and a light jacket if rain is forecast.

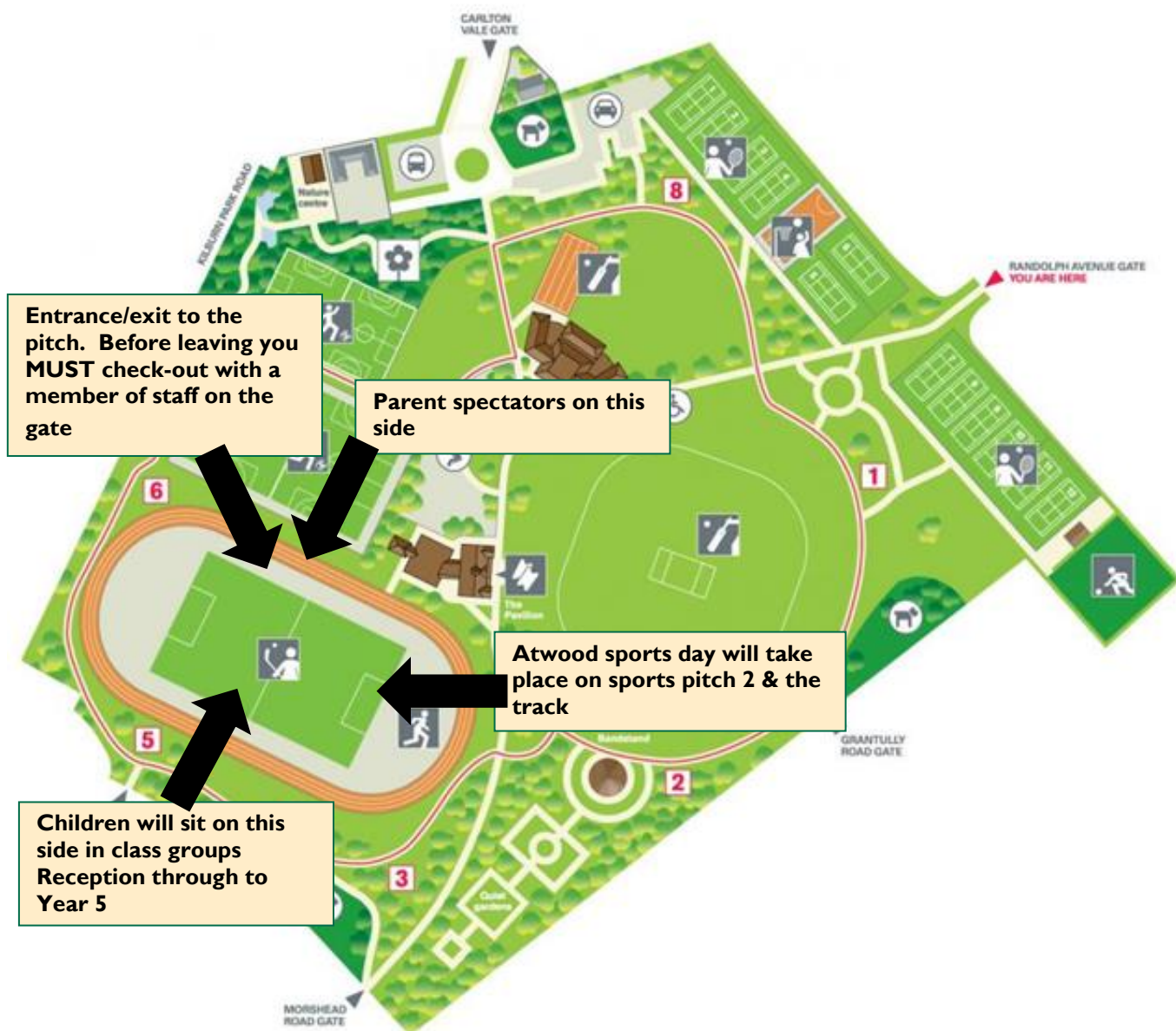
