Ark Atwood School Street Scheme

School Street Scheme is to be progressed for installation via an Experimental Traffic Order (ETO) and at a number of other primary schools.

This will be signs and lines initially and the schemes will be monitored to understand the changing traffic and travel patterns that may occur as we transition out of lockdown.

<p>School Streets to be installed with Experimental Traffic Orders for 18 months week beginning 19th April 2021 with signage only</p> <p>Communication with ward councillors, school community, residents and businesses prior to installation.</p> <p>Communication and training provided</p>	<p>During first 6 months of installation, consultation will be undertaken as well as traffic camera monitoring to aid any amendments to reflect the changing traffic and travel behaviours.</p> <p>Ongoing communication and training</p>	<p>Experimental Traffic Orders will come to an end after the 18 month period and the lead cabinet member for highways will confirm whether the scheme can be made permanent.</p>
