Dear Parents,

Welcome to the autumn term. It has been a pleasure to see all of our existing pupils and families as well as meet the new members of our school community. Despite the unseasonably mild weather, make no mistake – autumn term is in full swing. It's late September, and by now the rhythm of our days is carving the flow of our weeks. We have a very busy term ahead of us and we will endeavour to keep you up to date with what's been happening as well as forthcoming events via our twice termly newsletter and our Twitter account (@ARKAtwood). In 2011 Atwood opened with 45 pupils and 11 staff. This September sees Atwood full for the first time from Nursery to Year 6. Our school community is now comprised of over 450 children and 66 staff. We are a busy, inner London primary with such a vibrant school community and there is never a dull moment. The new school year has got off to a great start with excellent standards of behaviour – routines and structures are working. A particular highlight has been the introduction of mixed-age dining and playtimes.

This year we are elevating the focus on our Houses. New House Captains have been elected and we are eagerly awaiting the design of our house shields. We're currently thinking about how children can be identified by their House, e.g. badges, ties etc. We'll keep you posted.

We look forward to working with you and your children this year. With parents, staff and children working together in partnership I am sure that 2017-18 will be a most successful year for Atwood.

Parent Mail

- We can send messages directly to mums, dads and other carers at the same time
- Emergency or important information can be sent by text message
- iPhone and Android Apps available for parents on the go.

If you don't have an account or are having any difficulties with Parent Mail please speak to the office team. We really do want 100% of parents signed-up and engaging with us in this way.
